The typical strategy of brainstorming a list of search terms in an effort to narrow down a set of documents for review has several shortcomings.





Narrative Strategy Dramatically Improves Search Results

The goal in any information retrieval exercise is **optimal recall** *and* **precision** — or in other words, to find all documents that contain potentially relevant information while also reducing the retrieval of non-relevant documents. Crafting searches that combine all the components of key issues and the synonyms that are contained within the vocabulary of the data will result in the highest precision and minimize false positives.

The following case example centers on the issue of price fixing. There may be multiple expressions required to convey the full meaning of this issue. One path would be to find key documents that include any mention of meetings with competitors where prices were discussed.



Use Cases

Early Case Strategy

Understand the story of the case in the first 90 days to make more informed settle versus proceed and discovery strategies.

Targeted Collection

Combine iterative search- and indexin-place technologies to perform targeted collection.

Review Acceleration

Prioritize highly relevant information and propogate your seed set if using accelerated review methodologies.

Incoming Production Assessment

Analyze incoming documents quickly to correlate documents to discovery requests and identify any deficiencies.
